GENERAL INFORMATION for the Grade 3 & 4 Camp

Dear Parents,

The 2021 Grade 3 & 4 CAMP will take place from Monday 29th November – Wednesday 1st December at Arrabri Lodge, Warburton. Children need to be at school by 8.45 am on Monday 29th November. The buses will arrive back at the school between 2.45 & 3.15 pm on the final day of the camp.

Final Payment: Please note that your final payment for the camp is due no later than Friday 19th November.

Transport: Children will be transported to and from the venues by buses or the designated cars for the Camp. In all cases the designated car will be covered by comprehensive insurance, have indemnity to the crown and have a fitted seat belt for each occupant.

Emergency Contact: If you need to contact your child in case of an emergency phone the school during school hours (9308 1228). After hours contact Arrabri Lodge (03) 5966 2202.

What To Bring: A list of items required is attached to this notice. Please ensure they are clearly labeled with your child's name.

Confidential Medical Report: Attached is a Medical Form to provide us with important information concerning your child, as well as details regarding medication or special treatment, which may be required. At the conclusion of the camp these forms are destroyed.

Camp Activities:

Each campsite and venue visited have a number of facilities, which if in good condition, may be used by the children. All venues and equipment will be thoroughly checked by camp staff, and only used under strict supervision.

Activities which may be included on the Camp are a Night Walk, Table Tennis, Ball Games, Bush Dance, Ropes Course, Climbing Wall, Mini Golf, Archery, Flying Fox, Giant Swing or Sensory Trail.

WHAT TO BRING

PLEASE ENSURE ALL ITEMS ARE CLEARLY NAMED

ESSENTIAL ITEMS:

PILLOW, FITTED SHEET, SLEEPING BAG & DRINK BOTTLE

(Camp beds are covered with a plastic mattress protector that is disinfected and sanitized after every camp, therefore the single bed fitted sheet to go over the top is a must)

WRITING MATERIALS

Pen or Pencil

TOILETRIES

Toothbrush & Toothpaste
Soap (in soap holder)
Face washer
Shampoo (if required)
Sunscreen
Insect Repellent (For Mosquitoes)
Garbage bag for soiled clothes

EXTRAS

Children need to bring a plastic water bottle, to be replenished regularly whilst on camp.

Shorts/ T Shirts (No shoestring tops)
Jeans/long pants
Runners /Solid shoes (2 pair – one old, for Bushwalking)
Thongs/ slippers or Ugg boots for inside only

Underwear/ socks

POCKET MONEY: “Please Note” Children are not to bring pocket money with them on Camp.

No extra food to be packed in suitcases.

Children need to provide their own play lunch, plastic bottle with drink and lunch on the first day. Please pack this in a separate bag that the children will be able to take with them on the bus.

Parents, please label your child’s belongings. Luggage and sleeping bags are NOT to be tied together. (At the bus driver’s request, as packing the coach is difficult when items are tied together)

DEPARTURE INFORMATION

Children need to assemble inside the Gym on the day of departure. Buses will arrive & depart from the car park on Grand Boulevard. Parents are requested to take their children’s luggage to the bus when the children are being marked present. If you have medicine that your child needs to take on Camp, this needs to be in a clearly labeled container with information about when your child needs to take it and what dosage is required. A staff member will be in **the Gym** to collect these after 8.30 on the day of departure.
