ENGLISH

READING & VIEWING STRATEGIES:

- Use prior knowledge to connect with the text.
- Making inferences about texts read and using evidence from the text to support their thinking.
- Ask questions throughout the reading process.

WRITING:

Expose children to a variety of text types while focusing on information texts and persuasive texts.

- Write to persuade a reader on a certain thought or idea.
- Using paragraphs and editing strategies.

SPEAKING AND LISTENING:

- Speaking- Adjusting speaking for audience (tone, volume and pace) to emphasise meaning.
- Listening- Extend ideas in a constructive manner after listening to others (linked to reading and writing).
- Plan, rehearse and deliver presentations by selecting and sequencing appropriate content.

GRAMMAR AND WORD ENRICHMENT:

- Sentence Types – students will be looking at different types of sentences and how to incorporate them into their writing effectively. The sentences include;
- Question sentences
- Alliteration sentences
- List sentences
- Grammatically correct sentence structures



THUMBS UP

Students will participate in the 'Thumbs Up' program, focusing on social development and will also participate in weekly welfare lessons, which help them understand the role of listening and getting along with others. The students will also be encouraged to continue to use our school values of respect, responsibility, cooperation, integrity, optimism and friendliness

MATHEMATICS

NUMBER & PLACE VALUE:

- Revision of times tables and number patterns
- Addition, subtraction, multiplication and division strategies.

MEASUREMENT & GEOMETRY / STATISTICS & PROBABILITY:

- Area and perimeter
- Converting between decimal lengths
- Solving problems involving length and area
- Comparing data
- Interpreting and using timetables
- Measuring, calculating and comparing elapsed time



INQUIRY

Students will continue to discover 'Our World.' The students will learn about Australia's states and territories, the world's continents, major countries of Europe, North America, and Asia, and their relationship with Australia. Students will develop inquiry skills including targeted computer research strategies, critical thinking, posing relevant and interesting questions, evaluating ideas, reporting on the information they find, and making links to their lives and other learning.



HOMework

Students are expected to complete their Reading Eggs and Mathematics tasks every week.

Students need to record their home reading in their diaries and have it signed by a parent.

Homework books will be sent home in Term 2 to support the student's transition to secondary schooling. These will need to be completed and returned to school weekly.
